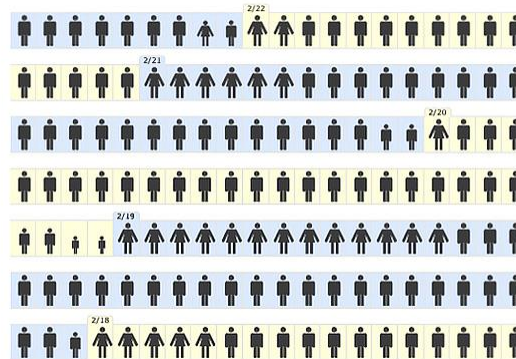

From 2003 through 2012

300,000 persons died from firearm-related injuries

- > U.S. combat fatalities in World War II
- > Combined count of combat fatalities in all other wars in the U.S. history

70,000 of those were < 24 years old

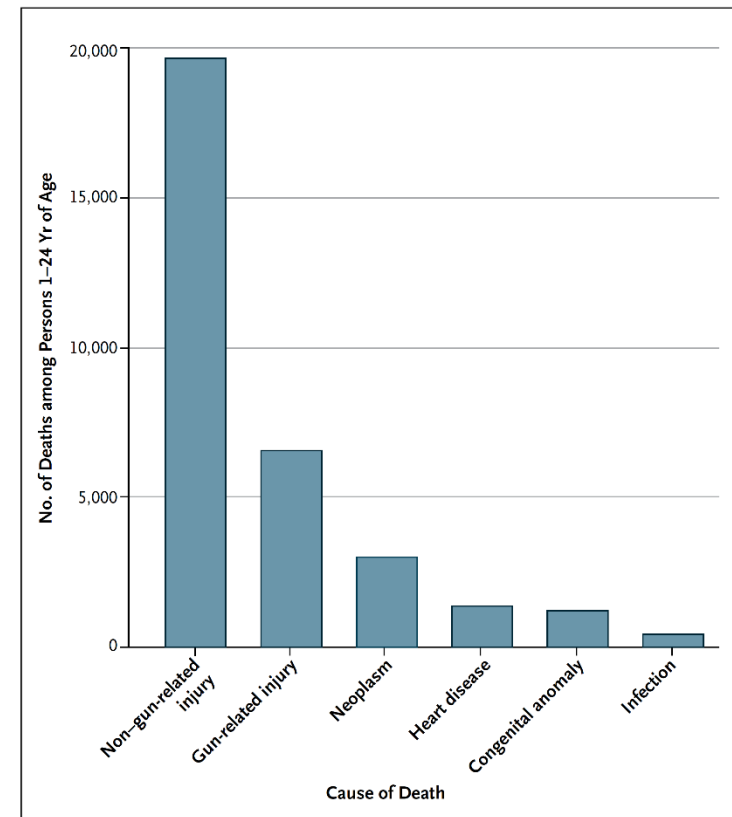
Among persons 1-24 years of age

Deaths caused by gun-related injuries:

2 times > cancer

5 times > heart disease

15 times > infections
